Please initial that you have read and reviewed the following: **General Information and Policies - Services- Placenta encapsulation is the process of preparing a mother's placenta within 48 hours of birth by separating the umbilical cord from the placenta, rinsing and draining maternal and fetal blood, steaming, dehydrating and powdering the placenta to be placed into vegetarian non-gelatin capsules for the mother to ingest as she sees fit. Optionally, mothers may choose to have placenta art prints made with their placenta on archival artist paper or canvas board. Some mothers choose to keep these in the baby book, a keepsake box, or to display them. The prints are another way to honor the placenta and to preserve the image of the "tree of life" that the placenta creates. Another option for mothers is the creation of a Placenta Tincture with a small portion of their placenta, prior to preparation for encapsulation. Tinctures rest for six weeks after the birth and can be used on their own in times of transition, stress and illness. Detailed instructions are provided for use. Always speak to your care provider regarding any questions about your health, safety and well-being. Placenta services are not meant to be a replacement for medical advice, medical care or medicine. If you experience symptoms of postpartum depression, low milk supply, etc. please call your care provider to discuss your symptoms and how to feel better as well as treat any existing symptoms or potential conditions. While many women have found placenta encapsulation to be a wonderful and amazing gift, you are still encouraged to seek appropriate assistance and medical care when necessary.
